

Shawville Curling Club **40th Annual Community Bonspiel**

Dear curlers;

On behalf of the Shawville Curling Club, we wish to welcome your participation in our 40th annual Community Bonspiel. The Bonspiel will be held from January 29th through to February 8th, 2015.

The sport of curling creates an atmosphere of friendly keen competition and fellowship. The Community Bonspiel is an event geared to all levels of curlers; from those who have never been inside a curling rink to seasoned players. Your team's abilities will be recognized and you will be placed in a division with other teams of similar caliber. Team divisions are designated by colors. A schedule will be available to all participants once all teams have been entered.

The Bonspiel Committee will do its very best to accommodate times or days that your team can or cannot curl. Scoring is via a points system, thus making it possible for any team in any division to be the eventual winner of the coveted "Toilet Seat" Trophy. We cannot emphasize enough times that this is a community fun event. Each team will chose a name and include it on the entry form.

Each team will play 3 games in its respective division. After each game (called a draw), the higher scoring teams will play against each other; the next highest scores will be paired off, and so on down the line. You will not play the same team twice. After the 3 games, the team with the highest score wins its division. Once all teams have completed play, the division winners with the highest points will win the "Toilet Seat".

Points are awarded as follows:

Win = 10 points.....Tie = 5 points.....Each end won = 2 points.....Blank end = 1 point
We use a plus/minus system calculation to determine the final scoring.

Once your team is officially registered, you can use a spare if necessary, once the Rules Committee has approved that spare.

In an effort to ensure that everyone receives a prize for his or her participation, we ask that each team bring in 4 prizes, to a maximum value of \$15 per gift. We ask that you bring in those prizes before the final weekend of play..

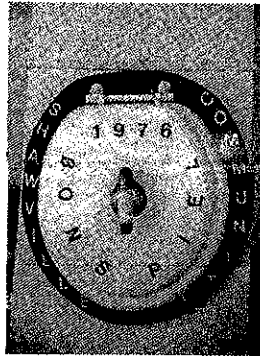
